ONE WINE, ONE RECIPE

LAURENT-PERRIER GRAND SIÈCLE ITÉRATION 26
TELMONT BLANC DE BLANCS EXTRA BRUT 2012
& PAN-FRIED SCALLOPS SERVED WITH AN ORANGE SAUCE

PREPARATION TIME: 10 MIN, COOKING TIME: 4 MIN
INGREDIENTS FOR 4 PEOPLE

16 Scallops
2 oranges
80 g butter

Salt
Pepper

PREPARATION:

Removing the orange slices and squeezing out the juice. Cut off the base and top of your orange. Remove the peel and all the white parts by following the curve of the fruit with the blade of your knife. Make V-shaped incisions along the segments to remove the slices. Squeeze the remaining flesh to extract the juice.

Cooking the scallops in butter. Heat the butter in a frying pan over a high heat. When the butter is sizzling, add the salted scallops and orange segments. Cook for 4 minutes, turning the scallops halfway through. Baste the scallops regularly with the butter.

Add the orange juice 30 seconds before the end of the cooking time. Season with pepper.

Arrange on a plate or in a dish with the orange slices and drizzle with the juice.

Mont d'Or
Château du Moulin-à-Vent 2021 Moulin-à-Vent

A seasonal cheese with characteristic woody notes, Mont d'Or is sublime when roasted and is a delight for lovers of runny cheeses. With its highly aromatic profile and subtle tannic structure, roasted Mont d'Or pairs perfectly with a lively, expressive red wine with mellow tannins.

Camembert
Domaine François Chidaine "Les Choisses" 2021 Montlouis-sur-Loire

Camembert is a creamy, powerful cheese that, especially when roasted, needs to be paired with a white wine that is also full of character. So, choosing a wine with an opulent expression, a lively structure and a long finish is the perfect option to stand up to it. Floral notes will add a seductive and complementary lightness.

Munster
Domaine Marcel Deiss Gewurztraminer Vendanges tardives 2018

Munster is undoubtedly one of the oldest French cheeses and takes its name from the Latin "monasterium" (meaning monastery in French). Contrary to its powerful and somewhat rustic smell, Munster has a rather mild flavour and reveals itself wonderfully when cooked. An aromatic, vibrant and slightly sweet wine will complement this cheese beautifully.

Etna wines, AN ERUPTION OF AROMAS

Produced in the foothills of Europe's highest active volcano, these Sicilian wines have enjoyed a phenomenal rise in popularity in recent years. And for good reason: they are the very definition of a local wine. The native grape varieties used for the red wines, mainly Nerello Mascalese (nicknamed Southern Nebbiolo), are influenced by the altitudes of the vineyards (sometimes over 1,000 metres above sea level), the various sun exposures and the composition of the volcanic soils on which they are planted.

Called "Contrada", these micro-terroirs are delimited according to the composition of the soil. Imagine million-year-old substrata on which lie layers of lava, the most recent dating from the twentieth century and the oldest from thousands of years ago. The expression of each wine is unique, ranging from intense to delicate, but always with a classy structure and remarkable ageing potential.

Château Margaux

PREMIER GRAND CRU CLASSÉ

With origins dating back to the twelfth century, Château Margaux is one of those Grands Crus that has shaped the reputation of Bordeaux's fine wines throughout the world. In 1855, the château was awarded the title of Premier Grand Cru Classé and was the only one of the four châteaux to achieve a score of twenty out of twenty.

Château Margaux owes its distinctive character to its rare and unique terroir. The estate's grape varieties include the area's flagship black grape, Cabernet Sauvignon, complemented by Merlot, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. The estate's clay-limestone soils give rise to legendary vintages that boast a racy, sensual allure. Finesse, rare elegance and complexity are the hallmarks of Château Margaux wines. With delicate aromas of rose and violet and concentrated notes of small black fruits, the aromatic palette gives off a distinctive character. On the palate, the density of the wine, superbly structured by highly concentrated tannins that are nonetheless free of astringency, is striking for its length and freshness.
